ANNOUNCEMENT FOR OPEN POSITIONS

The School of Dentistry of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki organizes for the academic year 2016-2017 Program of Postgraduate Studies in Dentistry according to the provisions of the decision no. 210817/Z1 (FEK 3608/B'/2014) of the Hellenic Ministry of Culture, Education and Religious Affairs and the transitional provisions of the Law 3685/08 for the following Disciplines:

1. **Basic Oral Sciences**
2. **Endodontology**
3. **Hospital Dentistry**
4. **Operative Dentistry – Conservative Aesthetic Restorations**
5. **Dentoalveolar Surgery and Radiology**
6. **Pediatric Dentistry**
7. **Periodontology**
8. **Prosthodontics**
9. **Oral Medicine and Pathology**

The total number of the Postgraduate students admitted in the above Disciplines cannot exceed fifty (50), while ten (10) of them are citizens of non-European Union Countries.

Only graduates of Schools of Dentistry of national Universities or graduates from foreign recognized Dental Institutions with a valid certification of equivalence by the Hellenic NARIC (www.doatap.gr) are admitted to the Program.

The selection of the candidates accepted in the program is based on the co-evaluation of the following criteria:

a.	Total grade of the Dental Degree	percentage 25 %
b.	The grades of the undergraduate courses related to the specific Discipline chosen by the candidate	percentage 15 %
c.	Other points of the candidate's Curriculum Vitae - Clinical experience in Dentistry gained after receiving the Dental Degree	percentage 15 %

d.	The candidate's previous research and scientific activity	percentage 15%
e.	The candidate's personality and scientific maturity as arisen during his/hers interview taken by the four-member Selection Committee of each Discipline	percentage 20 % (for the Disciplines with an examination) percentage 30 % (for the Disciplines without an examination)
f.	The candidate's scientific competence as proven by an examination on the field of the Discipline chosen. The examination is compulsory for the Disciplines of <u>Prosthodontics</u> , <u>Dentoalveolar Surgery & Radiology</u> , <u>Endodontology</u> , <u>Periodontology</u> and <u>Operative Dentistry – Conservative Aesthetic Restorations</u>	percentage 10 % (only for the Disciplines with an examination)

For all applicants, the certified knowledge of the English language level C2 is a mandatory requirement, as it can be proven by the certificates mentioned below:

1. Greek National Foreign Language Exam System (C2).
2. Certificate of Proficiency in English, University of Cambridge or Michigan.
3. International English Language Testing System (IELTS) - University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate (UCLES) - The British Council-IDP Education Australia IELTS Australia, total score 7.5 or higher.
4. London Tests of English Level 5-Proficient Communication-EDEXCEL.
5. City and Guilds Level 3 Certificate in ESOL International (reading, writing and listening)- MASTERY- and City and Guilds Level 3 Certificate in ESOL International (spoken)-MASTERY ή City and Guilds Certificate in International ESOL-MASTERY- and Guilds Certificate in International Spoken ESOL-MASTERY (submitted all together).
6. BULATS English Language Test, score 90-100, Cambridge University.
7. ISE IV Integrated Skills in English Level 3 Certificate in ESOL International Trinity College London.
8. OCNW Certificate in ESOL International at Level 3 (Common European Framework equivalent level C2).
9. ESB Level 3 Certificate in ESOL International All modes (Council of Europe Level C2).
10. Test of Interactive English, C2 Level.
11. Undergraduate or Postgraduate Degree received from foreign English-language University or Degree of the Faculty of English Literature from Greek University.

Additionally, the certificates mentioned below will also be accepted:

- a) Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC), total score 905 - Educational Testing Service/Chauncey, USA.
- b) TOEFL score: 220 old evaluation system, 80 new evaluation system.

For candidates from foreign countries, **certification of knowledge of the Greek language** is additionally required.

The interviews will take place between **5th – 16th June 2017**, according to the schedule that will be announced by the General Secretariat in the notice board of the School, as well as in the Schools' website <http://www.dent.auth.gr/?q=en/node/1097>).

The board with the candidates' final evaluation and ranking will be published on **30th of June 2017**.

Application Documents:

2. Copy of Degree Certificate. (For candidates from foreign countries, a valid certification of equivalence of their Dental Degree by the Hellenic NARIC (www.doatap.gr) is required).
3. Transcript of Records.
4. Curriculum Vitae (it can be downloaded from <http://www.dent.auth.gr/?q=en/node/1097>).
5. Certificates should be provided for any clinical practice, teaching, research or other scientific activity. The clinical experience is proven by: a) a certificate to run an authorized dental office along with the invoices issued for the services provided, or b) a certificate for previous dental experience in Armed Forces or other Service, or c) a certificate of registration in the Doctors' Social insurance Service.
6. English language knowledge certificate.
7. Other languages knowledge certificate.
8. For candidates from foreign countries a Greek language knowledge certificate is required in addition.
9. Recommendation letters.

The candidates have the right to apply for up to two (2) Disciplines of the Program. In case the candidates apply for two (2) Disciplines, two separate files are submitted, one for each discipline, mentioning the order of preference.

The postgraduate students who will be admitted to the Program should purchase at their own expenses the equipment necessary for their clinical and laboratory training, as well as pay the fee for their clinical practice, according to the Senate's decision and the Article 12 of the Internal Regulation of Postgraduate Program in Dentistry.
